Expedited permitting - Housing Services works closely with Building Services to ensure all SHIP projects are approved within three days or less if all information is provided by the contractor. The AHAC meets quarterly to discuss policies and procedures and determine if changes should be made to improve affordable housing opportunities. Any recommendations will be made to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. Permit fees are waived in accordance to the Local Housing Assistance Plan approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

Expediting Permitting - The plan is currently being implemented
On-going Review - The plan is currently being implemented

Expedited Permitting - All permits have been issued within the time frame unless the contractor does not provide the required information to the appropriate agency or department.
On-going Review - The AHAC reviews policies and procedures. The committee listens to recommendation from Planning Services, non-profits and for-profits in the area to provide a partnership to increase affordable housing.
Permit fee waiver - Housing Services monitors all permits issued for SHIP projects to ensure the permit fee is waived.

Support Services

Housing Services provides homeownership counseling and is a Community Platinum Partner with the Department of Children and Families.

Other Accomplishments

Housing Services has increased the opportunity to assist citizens of Sumter County through Affordable Housing funds due to the mitigation funds from developments and the sales of code properties.
