RESOLUTION NO. 13-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE NORTH SUMTER COUNTY UTILITY DEPENDENT DISTRICT REQUESTING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DISTRICT'S BOUNDARY, AMENDING THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE DISTRICT, AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 125.01(1)(k)2, FLORIDA STATUTES, BEING PROVIDED BY THE NORTH SUMTER COUNTY UTILITY DEPENDENT DISTRICT IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, created the North Sumter County Utility Dependent District ("District") by the adoption of Ordinance 2010-10 in accordance with Chapter 189, Florida Statutes; Chapter 125, Florida Statutes; and Article VIII, Section 1, Florida Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the District has been requested by the utility service provider for properties lying south of C.R. 466A within The Villages of Sumter DRI and The Villages of Wildwood DRI, to expand the boundaries of the District to include said properties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the District has reviewed the request and believes it is in the public interest to expand the District's boundaries for a variety of reasons, including efficiencies of scale, reduction of government duplication of services, and providing for collection of solid waste pursuant to Section 125.01(1)(k)2, Florida Statutes.




