

**AMENDMENT # 3 TO AGREEMENT
BETWEEN SUMTER COUNTY AND
VSC FIRE & SECURITY**

WHEREAS, on or about, August 10, 2010 VSC Fire & Security (“Fire and Security Alarm Contract”), and the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, a subdivision of the State of Florida (the “Board”), entered into an Agreement (the “Agreement”), in which the contractor agreed to provide Fire and Security Alarm services for specified buildings that are maintained by the Board, and;

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to more accurately memorialize the intentions of the parties with regard to the following item:

1. Expand the scope of service for work to be performed that was not included in the original contract agreement to encompass unforeseen repairs, maintenance and installation of fire and security system devices. These items are to include the following scope of service for work that is performed but not included in the original contract.

Unforeseen Sprinkler Repairs

1. Broken sprinkler head
2. Bad valve
3. Bad flow switch
4. Bad water gong
5. Bad flow or damaged back flow

Fire Alarm Panels

1. Bad pull station
2. Bad smoke detector
3. Bad strobe
4. Bad Batteries
5. Power surge blown panel
6. Cut wire

Hoods

1. Bad motor
2. Discharge of system
3. Bad Detectors

Extinguishers

1. Out of date and can not certify
2. Needs to be recharged after use
3. Adding one to new location

New Buildings

1. New extinguishers
2. New hoods
3. New fire alarm panel
4. New sprinklers

THEREFORE, the parties hereto, being fully advised of the terms herein, and having been advised by legal counsel, do hereby agree to amend the Agreement by this writing (the “Amendment”) and state the following:

1. That the “WHEREAS” recitals above are hereby acknowledged as true and accurate and are incorporated

as if stated herein.

2. It is agreed that the work to be done under this Contract is to provide all services as set forth in the "Fire & Security Alarm", proposal, standard specifications and any addenda thereto, said documents attached hereto and incorporated herein.
3. Any provisions of the Contract not replaced or contradicted by this Amendment remains in full force and effect, in the event of any conflict.
