



Dear Commissioner Breeden:

The Department has completed its review of the adopted comprehensive plan amendment for Sumter County (DEO Amendment Number 12-1ESR) adopted on September 25, 2012 by Ordinance Number 2012-12, which were received on October 3, 2012. We have reviewed the amendment in accordance with the expedited state review process set forth in Sections 163.3184(2), (3) and (5), Florida Statutes (F.S.), and have identified no provision that necessitates a challenge of the Ordinances adopting the amendments.

If this plan amendment is not challenged by an affected person, the amendment will become effective 31 days after the Department notified the County that the plan amendment package was complete. If this plan amendment is challenged by an affected person, the amendment will not become effective until the Department or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining the amendment to be "In Compliance." No development orders, development permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commence before becoming effective.
