HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Dana Waters, City Clerk of Webster, and Dennis Johnson, Webster Police Chief have submitted a request to have the City of Webster's "Annual Christmas Parade" on December 1, 2012. This year's parade will start at 5:50 p.m. and finish around 6:50 p.m. The parade route will be as follows: Start at the Sumter County Farmer's Market; go south on SR-471 to CR 478 (SE 1st Avenue) and ending on SE 2nd Street.

Detour route will be; West on C-478A, North on CR 743, West on CR 740, North on CR 747, East on CR 722, and back to SR-471. This is the same detour route that has been used in previous years.

The City of Webster's Police Department and the Sumter County Sheriff's Office will be responsible for the detour routes and will direct traffic through the intersections at the detour locations.

The City of Webster requests that Public Works install detour route signs, and provide barricades for the parade. City of Webster personnel will un-bag the detour signs, and set up detour route with the provided barricades and return them back to the Public Works yard.
