

ORDINANCE 2012-_____

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE NORTH SUMTER COUNTY UTILITY DEPENDENT DISTRICT; AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCE 2012-14; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida created the North Sumter County Utility Dependent District as a dependent special district by Ordinance 2010-10, in accordance with Chapter 189, Florida Statutes, Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Article VIII, Section 1 of the Florida Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to expand its boundaries thereby improving the efficiency of local government in the provision of those governmental functions authorized by Chapter 189, Florida Statutes, including the collection and disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed all factors as required by Chapter 189, and Section 125.01(1)(k)2, and after such review has determined that the expansion of the District and its collection of solid waste is in the public interest of the County and its residents for their existing and future health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the County acknowledges and recognizes that Florida Statutes 403, Part IV, Resource Recovery and Management, clearly articulates and affirmatively expresses state policy and empowers counties within the State of Florida with the responsibility and the authority to provide solid waste management services including solid waste collection and disposal services through public and private entities to meet the needs of the areas within the individual county; and

WHEREAS, the operations and actions of such collection and disposal services by the District as authorized hereunder by the County shall be supervised by the County and the District is directed to comply with Chapter 403, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida approved Ordinance 2012-14 on October 23, 2012, which is hereby amended and restated as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT ORDINANCE 2010-10 CODIFIED IN SECTION 22 OF THE SUMTER COUNTY CODE, IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 2 is amended by restating Section 2 as follows:

SECTION 2. DISTRICT BOUNDARY. The geographic boundary for the District shall include and incorporate all property described below:

A PARCEL OF LAND LYING WITHIN SECTIONS 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 33, 34, 35, AND 36, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 23 SOUTH, AND WITHIN SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, AND 4, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST, SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGIN AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 466-A WITH THE LINE BETWEEN RANGE 23 EAST (SUMTER COUNTY) AND RANGE 24 EAST (LAKE COUNTY), SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA;

THENCE RUN WESTERLY ALONG THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY OF COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 466-A TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 3/4 OF SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST;

THENCE DEPARTING AFOREMENTIONED RIGHT OF WAY LINE, RUN NORTHERLY ALONG THE SAID WEST LINE OF THE EAST 3/4 TO THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST;

THENCE RUN WESTERLY ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST;

THENCE RUN WESTERLY ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST TO THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST;

THENCE RUN NORTHERLY ALONG AFOREMENTIONED WEST LINE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST;

THENCE RUN WESTERLY ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 33 TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 462;

THENCE RUN NORTHERLY ALONG SAID EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE N00°30'01"E, 624.00 FEET;

- a. The governing body of the District (the “District Board”) shall exercise the powers granted to the District pursuant this Ordinance. The District Board shall consist of seven (7) members, none of whom shall be elected officials, employees or agents of the County. The members of the District Board, their terms of office and the seat they represent shall be as follows:

The members of Seats 1 through 4 shall be elected by qualified electors solely within the community development district in which they reside. c. Additional District Board Member Positions created Pursuant to this Amendment. Following the expiration of the terms of office of those members of the District Board created pursuant this Amendment, each member shall be elected by qualified electors as described below and shall hold office for a term of four years and until a successor is elected and qualifies. All elections shall be conducted in accordance with applicable state law and the provisions hereof. All members of the District Board must be residents of the District and, additionally, one member of the District Board must be a resident of Village Community District No. 9 (Seat 5), one member must be a resident of Village Community Development District No. 10 (Seat 6), and an at large member who must be a resident of Village Community Development Districts 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, or 10 (Seat 7). The County hereby appoints the following individuals to seats 5 through 7:

(5)	Nicolas Hemes	2 years
(6)	Patricia Francis	2 years
(7)	Erik Greulach	4 years

d. The members of the District Board must be citizens of the United States. For purposes of this subsection, qualified electors means any person at least 18 years of age who is a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of Florida and of the District, and who registers to vote with the supervisor of elections in the county in which the District land is located.

e. Elections of District Board members shall be nonpartisan and shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for holding general elections. Board members shall assume the office on the second Tuesday following their election.

f. Upon entering into office, members of the District Board shall take and subscribe to the oath of office as prescribed by s. 876.05, Florida Statutes. They shall hold office for the terms for which they were elected or appointed and until their successors are chosen and qualified. If, during the term of office, a vacancy occurs, the County shall fill the vacancy by an appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term.

g. A majority of the members of the District Board constitutes a quorum for the purposes of conducting its business and exercising its powers and for all other purposes. Action taken by the District shall be upon a vote of a majority of the members present unless general law or a rule of the District requires a greater number.

h. As soon as practicable after each election or appointment, the District Board shall organize by electing one of its members as chair and by electing a secretary, who

need not be a member of the District Board, and such other officers as the District Board may deem necessary.

i. The District Board shall keep a permanent record book entitled "Record of Proceedings of North Sumter County Utility Dependent District," in which shall be recorded minutes of all meetings, resolutions, proceedings, certificates, bonds given by all employees, and any and all corporate acts. The record book shall at reasonable times be open to inspection in the same manner as state, county, and municipal records pursuant to Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. The record book shall be kept at the office or other regular place of business maintained by the District Board in Sumter County.

j. All meetings of the District Board shall be open to the public and governed by the provisions of Chapter 286, Florida Statutes.

k. Each member of the District Board shall be entitled to receive for his or her services an amount not to exceed \$200 per meeting of the District Board, not to exceed \$4,800 per year.

l. At the time a vacancy occurs in the District Board during a member's term, the vacancy shall be filled by the County. The person appointed shall hold office for the balance of the term and shall meet all qualifications under state law and this Ordinance.

3. Section 3 is amended by the inclusion of a new Subsection t.

t. The right to collect and dispose of solid waste within those portions of the Tri-County Villages of Sumter Development of Regional Impact, Villages of Sumter Development of Regional Impact, together with Bison Valley Subdivision, Plat Book 10, Page 12, Public Records of Sumter County, Florida; Glen Hollow Farms, Plat Book 4, Page 138, Public Records of Sumter County, Florida; and Lakes and Live

Oak Community, an unrecorded subdivision all located within unincorporated Sumter County, Florida. The right to collect and dispose of solid waste within the residential portions of areas described above shall be exclusive. Such right shall commence upon the designation of the District by the Developer pursuant to authorizations contained in the Development Orders for Tri-County Villages of Sumter Development of Regional Impact and Village of Sumter Development of Regional Impact.

4. Section 10 is amended by restating Section 10 as follows:

SECTION 10. FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE. The District is a financially independent political subdivision, and the District shall be solely responsible for its own accounting and auditing functions in accordance with Florida law. Provided that the District is in compliance with its accounting and auditing functions, the County covenants that so long as District bonds or other debts or obligations remain outstanding, the County will take no action that impairs the District's ability to pay such bonds, debts or other obligations, or to dissolve the District.

5. Only Specific Sections Amended.

Except as amended herein, all other existing terms and provisions of Ordinance 2010-10 as codified in Section 22 of the Sumter County Code shall remain unchanged and Ordinance 2012-14 is hereby amended and restated as set forth herein.

6. Effective Date.

The provisions of this amendment and restatement of Ordinance 2012-14 shall become effective upon acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State that this Ordinance has been filed with that office.
