HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

The Sumter County Code presently prohibits bottle clubs, as defined in Section 3-3, from operating in Sumter County. However, the Land Development Code provides for Bottle Clubs as a Special Land Use Permit in the Heavy Commercial and Regional Commercial Land Use Zones. The proposed amendment will resolve this conflict by deleting the prohibition and providing a definition of "bottle club" in the Land Development Code. The current provisions for bottle clubs as a Special Permit Use would remain in place.

The ZAB recommended approval of the amendment to the Land Development Code by a 5-0 vote at their December 3rd regular meeting with the condition that Bottle Clubs continue to be a Special Permit Land Use requiring Commission approval.
