ITB 143-0-2009/AT C-470 Sidewalk Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting held on 11-12-2009 at 10:30 am in the Public Works Conference Room located at 319 E. Anderson Avenue, Bushnell, FL 33513.

Bill Stevens, Dale Parrett, and Amanda Taylor were present to represent staff. Jane Caldera with Volkert & Associates, Inc. was present as the Engineer of Record.

Amanda stated the sign-in sheet was being passed around and if the company did not sign in and submitted a bid on the bid due date their bid would be rejected.

Amanda reviewed the dates as follows: 11-25-09 at 5pm was the last day for questions, 12-7-09 at 10:00am was when bids were due, the bids would be opened at 10:05am in Room 142 located at the Government Offices, 910 North Main Street, Bushnell, FL, 33513, the Selection Committee will meet on 12-8-09 at 10:00am in Room 142, and a recommendation for award would be taken to the BOCC on 12-29-09.

Amanda then turned the meeting over to Bill and Jane.

Jane stated the plans were not prepared in great detail so detail design would need to be provided by the selected company's surveyor. She also stated some utility conflicts so they will need to be monitored once the project starts, and their will be an enhancement on the crossing at C-470 south of CR 479.

Bill stated this is a federal stimulus project so all guidelines and reporting must be met by the contractor and that it is the responsibility of the contractor to maintain these requirements. Jane also stated that FDOT will be visiting the site on a regular basis to make sure all guidelines are being followed.

Questions were asked as follows: 1. are the truncated domes and incidental pay item, the answer is yes they are noted as a pay item; 2. how often do you have to put cylinders in the concrete, Jane stated she will have to verify and respond later; 3. who will do the testing, answer Sumter County will have a private testing company do all testing; 4. is a construction trailer required, answer the specifications say only a project board is required; 5. Item 1.1086 is it a lump sum item, answer yes, sign templates, and no guard rail required; 6. excavation on project, answer no substantial excavation recommended that the contractors drive the path to verify before submittal of the bids.

The meeting adjourned at 10:45am.

ITB 143-0-2009/AT C-470 Sidewalk Bid Opening Meeting held on 12-7-09 at 10:05am in Room 142 located at the Government Offices, 910 North Main Street, Bushnell, FL 33513.

Amanda Taylor with the Budget & Purchasing Department stated that bids were due at 10:00am on 12-7-09. Seven bids were received on time, zero bids were received late, and zero "No Proposals" were submitted. Amanda stated the Selection Review Committee would meet on 12-8-09 at 10:00am in Room 142. Recommendation from the Selection Committee will be sent to the Board of Sumter County Commissioners on 12-29-09.

Amanda stated two addendums were to be acknowledged, and four packets were to be included with one clearly marked as original and three marked as copies. Amanda stated that the company had to be in attendance at the Mandatory Pre-Bid meeting in order for the bid to be accepted.

The bids were opened in no particular order as follows:

1. RJP Enterprises, Inc. – 4 packets, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$421,207.56
2. Croft Contracting – 3 packets with 1 copy missing, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$299,590.05
3. Art Walker Construction – 4 packets, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$327,750.81
4. Semper Fi Services – 4 packets, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$337,473.42
5. R. Cobb Construction – 1 original no copies, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$499,000.43
6. Beesley Construction Company – 4 packets, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$325,611.41
7. Daly & Zilch, Inc. – 4 packets, 2 addendums acknowledged, total price \$349,870.00

ITB 143-0-2009/AT C-470 Sidewalk Selection Review Committee Meeting held on 12-8-2009 at 10:00am in Room 142 at the Government Offices, 910 North Main Street, Bushnell, FL 33513.

Amanda Taylor with the Budget & Purchasing Department stated a recommendation from the Selection Committee would be made to the Board of Sumter County Commissioners on 12-29-2009. Amanda stated Public Works verified all contractor submissions regarding pre-qualification with the County or with FDOT. One company Beesley Construction was neither County nor FDOT pre-qualified so they were eliminated from the bid process.

Amanda stated the lowest priced contractor was Croft Construction Inc. Croft submitted a complete bid except for being one copy short as required in the bid. Amanda stated she made the extra copy and did not think that was of great concern but needed a ruling from the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee consisted of Bill Stevens, Dale Parrett, and Jane Caldera. The Committee agreed one copy missing was not of great concern and would not cause Croft Construction Inc. to be eliminated from the bid process.

Jane Caldera with Volkert & Associates, Inc. stated the bid amounts were correct with Croft Construction Inc. being the lowest bidder and providing a complete bid packet.

Bill made a motion to recommend award to Croft Contracting Inc. to the Board of Sumter County Commissioners at their regular scheduled meeting on 12-29-2009 for the C-470 Sidewalk bid. Dale seconded the motion. All were in favor and none opposed.

Bill stated Amanda would contact Croft Contracting Inc. and let them know a start date was needed and someone would need to come to the office in Bushnell and get the paperwork that needs to be signed and returned so it could be submitted to the Board of Sumter County Commissioners on 12-29-2009.
