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**HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:**

The engineering firm of Dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precourt, Inc. (DRMP) is currently under contract to conduct a Preliminary Design and Environmental Study (PD&E) for C-470 between I-75 and the Lake County line. As part of this study, DRMP was to develop alternative routes and cost estimates to eliminate the staggered alignment that exist at the intersection of SR 35 (US 301). The PD&E study has reached a stage that requires the Board of County Commissioners to make a determination of the final routing and right-of-way width. The possible routings were previously presented for comment at the second public meeting which was conducted by DRMP at the Lake Panasoffkee Recreation Park on February 25, 2010.

Sumter County Public Works is requesting a public hearing be set for May 11, 2010 before the Board of County Commissioners to facilitate a presentation by DRMP, final public input and decision regarding the study alternatives.

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
