HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Randy Messer, with FDS Disposal, Inc. contacted staff, requesting a sixty (60) day time extension to remove CC-176-LF the Recyclable Material Recovery System, making the new removed by date May 31, 2010. FDS Disposal, Inc. is requesting a one hundred twenty (120) day time extension to remove CC-182-LF Digester #2, making the new removed by date July 31, 2010. The Board approved to award these items to FDS Disposal, Inc. from ITB 146-0-2010/AT approved on 3-9-2010.

Both extensions will allow FDS Disposal, Inc. to disassemble the equipment safely and accurately so the equipment will not be damaged in the moving process. The Material Recovery System will be utilized for the planned recycling processing center in Wildwood, and will benefit Sumter County in the diversion of recyclables out of the current waste stream.

FDS Disposal, Inc. is also requesting to purchase CC-166-LF Digester #1 in the amount of \$3,000.00. This will be used by FDS Disposal, Inc. as parts for Digester #2 as needed. Digester #1 will be removed at the same time as Digester #2 along with all of its associated auxiliary equipment.

Staff has communicated with FDS Disposal, Inc. that under no circumstances will County staff be involved or assist with any expenses incurred with the moving process nor will assistance be provided to FDS Disposal, Inc. to remove the equipment. FDS Disposal, Inc. agrees to these terms.
