HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

The original request pertained to the section of SR 44 to C-44A to ensure that there was not conflict with the Villages naming this section of road as Powell Road. I provided a statement of no objection to their proposed name based on the following:

1. The Villages was granted the authority to address the entire DRI including names of roads and address ranges.
2. The section of road between SR 44 and C-44 A is within the DRI.

An additional request was received verbally to change the name of CR 139 to Powell Road from C44A to C-466A due to the fact that significant right-of-way was donated to the County for widening of CR 139 from a rural "farm" road to a 4-lane road to support the northern entrance to the Brownwood Downtown Development of the Villages of Wildwood. Further, this road abuts the westerly portion of Downtown Development of the Villages of Wildwood. Further, this road abuts the westerly portion of the DRI and will provide a westerly entract to the commercial area of Pinellas Plaza. For consistency of the regionally significant road from SR 44 to C-466A that it bear the same name for its entire length.

The residents along with CR 139 that were impacted by the right-of-way were more than fairly compensated by Sumter County in its acquisition of the right-of-way as well as the strong potential for an increase in their asset due to the development that is occurring and will occur in this area.

The Board's Options are:

1. Conduct the Public Hearing to rename CR 139 to Powell Road
 2. Do Nothing
