We have been working in conjunction with Peninsula Compost on the possibility of operating the digester at its current location. It is both parties intent to utilize this equipment for its best intended use so it is imperative that we explore all options prior to moving the equipment, due to the cost involved \$900,000. The BOCC has been extremely patient with our project, and has bent over backwards to help us in our goal to see this equipment utilized for its best intended purposes. The Boards patient with this project show's their sincere commitment to our environment. We sincerely hope we will have the opportunity to keep the digester in place, and help Sumter County in the creation of new green jobs, and help the BOCC achieve the states new recycling goals. In the event our proposal is unworkable, and we need to continue forward with our due diligence to find a suitable location to move the digester.
