

SUMTER COUNTY ORDINANCE 2010-\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING ORDINANCE 2010-10 SOLELY FOR PURPOSES OF CLARIFICATION PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida have determined that Ordinance 2010-10 requires amendments only to fill in references to subsequently passed ordinances and to clarify codification language.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, that Ordinance 2010-10 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: The language of Ordinance 2010-10 is to be codified in Chapter 22, Sumter County Code.

SECTION 2: Section 3 s. of Ordinance 2010-10 is stricken in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

s. At the request of the County or any of its agencies, to provide assistance thereto in connection with the carrying out of any police functions.

The District shall have such duties as are imposed on it by Chapter 189, Florida Statutes, and other applicable laws. With the exception of the above specifically enumerated powers, any conflict between this ordinance and Sumter County Ordinances 2009-07 and 2010-12 shall be interpreted in favor of Ordinances 2009-07 and 2010-12 and the terms of those ordinances and the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreements and Joint Planning Agreements enacted or amended thereby shall prevail.

SECTION 3. *Codification.* It is the intention of the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Sumter County Code and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word or phrase and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention.

SECTION 4. *Severability.* If any provision of this

Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall not effect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given the effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provision of this act are declared severable.

SECTION 5. *Effective Date.* This Ordinance shall take effect on November 9, 2010.
