

Thanks for all the hard work and response to date. Here is where I see this going.

1. Mark and Betty - Work done to date by Guardian/AET – see attached invoice for \$25,575.37 and email below. Original emergency PO was for \$35,000.
 - a. Get a statement from Guardian that AET's work under the original emergency PO is complete.
 - b. Get a written copy of AET's results and recommendations from the original emergency PO.
 - c. Close out the original emergency PO with Guardian/AET.
2. Mark, Betty and Denise – work with Karen and Amanda to amend the second emergency PO #53897 from \$20,000, to NTE \$25,781.63 for the full scope attached above from AET. I mentioned this to Bradley at his weekly meeting this AM.
 - a. Get John Marks in here to meet with us ASAP. I see the difference between his first estimate and second one, but I want him to explain it better to us.
3. Lita – please review the proposed AET contract language, and their terms and conditions for the \$25,781.63, attached. OK? Who signs? Me, you or Bradley?
4. Lita – please tell us how and when the insurance company takes over direct payments, or how we get reimbursed for all after the first \$10,000.
5. Advanced Environmental Technologies, LLC (AET) appreciates the opportunity to provide you with this proposal to initiate an Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) at the above referenced facility. All field activities will be performed in accordance with Florida regulations governing groundwater and soil sample collection procedures. AET is pleased to submit this cost proposal for your review.

PROPOSED SCOPE OF SERVICES

The following briefly outlines the tasks involved to perform the proposed free product removal and the Site Assessment Report to be submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP):

Free Product Recovery

AET will oversee the installation of one (1), 4-inch diameter recovery well (RW-1) adjacent to the dispenser numbered 5/6 by Huss Drilling Inc. The recovery well will be installed to 15 feet with 10 feet of screen. AET will also oversee a vacuum event to remove free product and petroleum contact water from the recovery well prior to initiating formal site assessment.

Soil and Groundwater Investigation

AET proposes one day of soil assessment activities, which includes completion of soil borings along the storm drain and outlet. The borings will be completed using a core drill and hand auger in order to collect appropriate laboratory analytical samples. It is estimated that up to eight (8) soil borings will be completed.

As part of the field activities, AET will field screen soil at each soil boring location using an organic vapor analyzer (OVA) at 5 ft depth intervals. AET will advance soil borings to a maximum depth of 12 ft bls. Up to three (3) soils samples corresponding to the high, medium and low OVA measurements will be collected for laboratory analysis.

AET will oversee the installation of four (4) shallow monitoring wells and one (1) double cased deep monitoring well to be installed by Huss Drilling. The location of the deep monitoring well will be adjacent to the recovery well to determine the vertical extent of contamination. The four (4) shallow wells will be placed approximately 30 feet from the recovery well in four separate directions to evaluate the horizontal extent of the groundwater contamination.

While on site, AET staff will perform an area survey to meet the requirements of Chapter 62-770 F.A.C. The site reconnaissance includes the following activities:

- A visual reconnaissance of the site and adjacent properties
- A potable well search

Reporting

Once all above referenced activities have been completed and final laboratory results have been received, AET will provide a Site Assessment Report. In this report, AET will include a description of all the work completed in the field, soil boring lithological logs, and any further recommendations. A map illustrating the soil and groundwater laboratory analytical will also be provided.

Project Compensation


Based on the above estimates, AET proposes to perform the above referenced activities at an estimated cost not to exceed **\$26,136.21** without prior approval from the client or insurance.

A.E.T. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY. AET shall perform services consistent with skill and care ordinarily exercised by other professional consultants under similar circumstances at the time services are performed, subject to any limitations established by CLIENT as to degree of care, time or expense to be incurred or other limitations of this Agreement. No other representation, warranty or guaranty, express or implied, is included in or intended by AET's services, proposals, agreements or reports.

RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES. Nothing shall be construed or interpreted as requiring AET to assume the status of owner, operator, generator, person who arranges for disposal, transporter or storer, as those terms or any other similar terms are used in any federal, state or local statute, regulation, ordinance or order governing the treatment, handling, storage or disposal of any toxic or hazardous substance or waste.

BILLING AND PAYMENT. Invoices will be submitted monthly and shall be due and payable within (30) days from invoice date. Interest at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.50%) per month, but not exceeding the maximum rate allowable by law, shall be payable on any amounts that are due but unpaid within thirty (30) days from receipt of invoice, payment to be applied first to accrued late payment charges and then to the principal unpaid amount. AET may (and Vendor hereby acknowledges), at its option, withhold delivery of reports or any other data pending receipt of payment for services rendered.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY. In consideration of potential liabilities which may be disproportionate to the fees to be earned by AET, CLIENT agrees to limit the liability of AET, its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, agents, and representatives to CLIENT for all claims or legal proceedings of any type arising out of or relating to the performance of services under this Agreement (including, but not limited to, AET's breach of the Agreement, its professional negligence, errors and omissions and other acts) to the greater of \$100,000 or the amount of AET's fee for the project relating to the services. Failure of CLIENT to give written notice to AET of any claim of negligent act, error or omission within one (1) year of performance shall constitute a waiver of such claim by CLIENT. Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, special or consequential loss or damages.

INDEMNIFICATION. Subject to the limitation of liability set out above, each party agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other from any claim, suit, liability, damage, injury, cost or expense, including attorney's fees, (hereafter collectively called "Loss") arising out of any breach of this Agreement and not arising out of willful misconduct or gross negligence.

TIME OF PERFORMANCE. AET makes no warranties regarding the time of completion of services and shall not be in default of performance under this Agreement where such performance is prevented, suspended or delayed by any cause beyond AET's control. Neither party will hold the other responsible for damages for delays in performance caused by acts of God or other events beyond the control of the other party and which could not have been reasonably foreseen or prevented. Such delays will extend completion dates commensurately.

CHANGED CONDITIONS. If, during the course of the performance of Services, conditions or circumstances develop or are discovered which were not contemplated by AET and which materially affect AET's ability to perform or which would materially increase the costs to AET of performing, then AET will notify CLIENT in writing, and AET and CLIENT shall renegotiate in good faith the terms of this Agreement within thirty (30) days. Alternatively, either party shall thereupon have the right to terminate the Agreement; provided, however, that upon any such termination, AET shall be compensated for services rendered to the date of termination.

AET'S REMEDY FOR BREACH OF AGREEMENT. Upon Client's and/or Co-Obligor's failure to perform its obligations under this Agreement in a timely fashion, AET may, at its election, terminate the contract entirely. Client's obligation to pay AET any fees and expense shall be timely if paid within 30 days after the date such fees and expenses are invoiced. Client's obligation to cure any dangerous, hazardous, or unsafe condition shall be timely if it is cured immediately upon receiving notice of such condition. All other obligations shall be considered performed timely if such obligations are completed within 30 days after such obligation arises by operation of law or by the terms of this Agreement. The parties hereby agree that if AET terminates this Agreement, AET shall have no further obligation to perform under this Agreement, and all outstanding amounts will be immediately due and payable. Further, if AET terminates this Agreement, the indemnification provisions contained herein shall survive such termination, and the obligations related thereto shall continue notwithstanding such termination.

CLIENT'S REMEDY OF BREACH OF AGREEMENT. If AET fails to perform in the manner provided by this Agreement, Client shall notify AET of such non-compliance, specifying each non-compliance with sufficient specificity to allow AET to correct such non-compliance (hereinafter "Notice of Non-Compliance"). AET shall have a period of thirty days from the date of the receipt of the Notice of Non-Compliance from Client to correct such non-compliance. If AET fails to correct the non-compliance, Client may elect to terminate the Agreement. The Agreement shall not be terminated until AET receives written notice mailed to 208 N. Magnolia Street, Albany, Ga. 31707, of such termination. If Client terminates the Agreement, Client shall remain obligated on all outstanding balances. Further, the indemnification provisions contained herein shall survive the termination, and the obligations related thereto shall continue notwithstanding the termination. Upon termination, AET shall have no further obligations arising under this Agreement.

ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS. If AET is required to file or defend any action to enforce or interpret provisions of this Agreement, AET shall be entitled to recover all reasonable attorney's fees, costs and expenses, including staff time at current billing rates, court costs and other claim-related expenses. If AET is required to respond to any order for the production of documents or becomes a witness in any proceeding regarding the Services, Client agrees to pay AET time and materials based on AET's then current schedule of charges and to reimburse AET for all costs and expenses incurred by AET not reimbursed by others, in responding to such order, including attorney's fees.

GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced in accordance with laws of the State of Georgia. 


