Dear Mr. Kuhl:

The Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement (Agreement) executed by your agency and the Florida Department of Transportation (Department) allows the Department to reimburse local governments for a portion of the cost to maintain and operate traffic signals on the state highway system. This Agreement has been amended to now include compensation for the maintenance and operation of intersection control beacons, beginning with the Department's fiscal year 2010-2011 (July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011). Payment for intersection control beacons will be at 25% of the rate for full traffic signals.

Enclosed is Amendment #1 which includes Exhibit A and Exhibit B. Exhibit A lists each existing traffic signal and intersection control beacon that will qualify for reimbursement from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. Exhibit B defines the method and limits of compensation for them.
