HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

On November 13, 2007, the County entered into an contract with the Sumter County Native American Family Tribe.

As a support to kick start their plans the County committed to \$20,000 over a 2 year period ending September 30, 2009 in in-kind services which was performed at an actual cost of \$20,744.09.

Based on the fact that Mr. Howard Oxedine, a duly authorized member and representative of the Sumter County Native American Family Tribe, continues to act in an un-businesslike fashion accusing the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners of racial discrimination due to his lack of understanding of the Florida Constitutional discretionary right the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners possesses.

Based on the fact that without funding support from Sumter County, Mr. Oxedine states that they are unable to fulfill the development of the Native American Park which is the purpose of the contract.

Based on the fact that the Sumter County Tourist Development Council (TDC) recommended funding by the Tourist Development Tax Fund with reservations of the Sumter County Native American Family Tribe being able to operate or further the growth of a park to which the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners echoed the reservations and has yet to accept the recommendation of the TDC.

Based on the fact that the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners tabled indefinitely any consideration of providing tourist development tax funds for this project.

Therefore, I recommend that a separation of the relationship between the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners and the Sumter County Native American Family Tribe is in the best interests of the County and each party in the contract.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, by and between Sumter County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, the governing body hereof, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY", and Sumter County Native American Family Tribe, a State-recognized 501C3 nonprofit organization, hereinafter referred to as the "Native Tribe".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the Southwest Florida Water Management District, hereinafter referred to as "SWFWMD", entered into that certain Lake Panasoffkee Sumter County Park Management Agreement (the "SWFWMD Agreement") on March 12, 2007, and;

WHEREAS, the NATIVE TRIBE wishes to develop a Native American Village and Historical Site; and promote and sponsor various educational historical related events and programs (i.e.: Pow Wows, Pioneer Events, Educational Programs, etc.) on a portion of the seventy (70) acre site governed and controlled by the SWFWMD Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY recognizes, respects, and wishes to assist the NATIVE TRIBE in promoting programs and projects which enhance historical educational recreational opportunities for the citizens of Sumter County and the surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY recognizes the ability of the NATIVE TRIBE to aid in conducting programs by providing personnel and other resources in the parks; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY gratefully accepts the assistance now offered by the NATIVE TRIBE in providing and enhancing facilities and programs in COUNTY parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and covenants contained herein and for other valuable considerations, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the NATIVE TRIBE and the COUNTY agree to the following:

1. RECITALS: The WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made part of this agreement as if set forth fully herein.

2. AGREEMENTS, ORDINANCES, CODES AND RULES: The NATIVE TRIBE agree to comply with all applicable Agreements, Ordinances, Codes, Rules, and Regulations of the COUNTY and agree to conduct all activities on the COUNTY' property (either owned or leased) in compliance with same. Furthermore, the NATIVE TRIBE agrees to abide by and operate in accordance with all terms of the SWFWMD Agreement, said agreement being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein *in haec verba*. The NATIVE TRIBE hereby acknowledges that it is on notice of the terms and requirements of the SWFWMD Agreement, and has had a change to fully review and comprehend the SWFWMD Agreement prior to its execution of this agreement.

3. FACILITIES, STRUCTURES, AND OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE: The NATIVE TRIBE acknowledge that all facilities, structures, and infrastructure proposed by the NATIVE TRIBE must be approved by the COUNTY, as well as SWFWMD, under the terms of paragraph four (4) of the SWFWMD Agreement. Furthermore, such proposed facilities, structures, and infrastructure must receive COUNTY Building Department Permit Approvals or Exemptions prior to construction, and

must be constructed in an authentic manner, in the character of the Florida and Southeast Native American Tribe structures. Such structures may only be semi-permanent.

4. COLLECTED MONEY: All money, funds, or donations, etc. collected by the NATIVE TRIBE shall be documented in detail and made available for review upon request by the COUNTY. All money, funds, or donations, etc. collected by the NATIVE TRIBE, excluding associated activity or event expenses, shall be used for the purpose of providing funding for the development, maintenance, security and ongoing operating expense of this site. The COUNTY and NATIVE TRIBE may mutually agree in writing upon donated equipment, supplies, or services in lieu of money or funds.

5. INSURANCE: The NATIVE TRIBE shall procure and maintain insurance as provided herein for the duration of this agreement, with the term of said insurance commencing on the effective date of this agreement, said "effective date" being the date in which the last party signs this agreement. The cost of said insurance shall be borne by the NATIVE TRIBE.

The NATIVE TRIBE shall furnish certificate(s) of insurance as outlined in Paragraph 4 Sections A and B. The certificate(s) shall clearly indicate that the NATIVE TRIBE has obtained insurance of the type, amount, and classification required for strict compliance with this agreement, and that no reduction in coverage or in limits, suspension, or cancellation of the insurance shall be occur during the life of this Agreement. The certificate(s) shall be signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. The COUNTY reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required policies at any time. Each insurance policy required by this agreement shall be endorsed to state that coverage shall not be suspended, voided, canceled, or reduced in coverage or in limits without the written agreement of the COUNTY. Such suspension, cancellation or reduction in coverage or limits shall be considered a default by the NATIVE TRIBE under the terms of this agreement, thus allowing immediate termination of this agreement by the County.

Compliance with the foregoing requirements shall not relieve the NATIVE TRIBE of the liability and obligations under this agreement. Neither approval by the COUNTY nor a failure to disapprove insurance certificates or policies furnished by the NATIVE TRIBE shall release the NATIVE TRIBE of full responsibility for all liability or its obligations under this agreement.

All insurance policies shall be issued by responsible companies authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Florida, have an "A" policyholders' rating, have a financial rating of at least Class VIII in accordance with the most current Best's Key Rating Guide, and shall be satisfactory to the COUNTY in its sole and absolute discretion. All policies of insurance required by this agreement shall be primary insurance as respects the COUNTY, its officials, agents and employees. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the COUNTY, its officials, agents or employees shall be in excess of the NATIVE TRIBE' insurance and shall not contribute with it. All policies of insurance required by this agreement, except Workers' Compensation, shall specifically provide that the COUNTY shall be an "additional insured" under the policy and shall contain a Severability of Interests provision. All insurance policies required herein shall apply to all operations, activities, or use by the NATIVE TRIBE or anyone volunteering, employed by or contracting with the NATIVE TRIBE. The insurance coverage's and limits provided herein are designated to meet the minimum requirements of the COUNTY. Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared

to and approved by the COUNTY and are the responsibility of the NATIVE TRIBE. The minimum kinds and limits of coverage to be carried by the NATIVE TRIBE shall be as follows:

a. Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability :

If the NATIVE TRIBE fall under the State of Florida Workers' Compensation Law, the NATIVE TRIBE shall provide coverage for all employees. The coverage shall be for the statutory limits in compliance with the applicable State and Federal laws. The policy must include employer's liability with a limit of \$100,000 each accident. The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the COUNTY, its officials, agents, and employees for losses arising from the leased premises.

b. Comprehensive General Liability :

Shall include premises and/or operations, broad form property damage, independent contractors, products liability and contractual liability, and shall be written on an "occurrence basis".

Bodily Injury and Personal Injury,

In addition, the NATIVE TRIBE shall require that third parties and entities including, but not limited to, food, merchandise and games, concessionaires, and/or vendors providing goods and services for remuneration, and which are affiliated with the NATIVE TRIBE, shall procure and maintain insurance that shall specifically provide that the NATIVE TRIBE and COUNTY shall be an "additional insured" and that the insurance shall be consistent with the minimum kinds and limits of coverage as set forth above.

6. INDEMNIFICATION: The NATIVE TRIBE shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the COUNTY and all of its agents and employees from any claim, loss, damage, cost, charge, or expense, including attorney's fees and costs, arising from or in connection with: (1) any work or thing whatsoever done, or any condition created in or about the COUNTY'S parks or property during the term of this agreement; (2) any act, omission, or negligence of the NATIVE TRIBE or any of the NATIVE TRIBE' licensees or the partners, directors, officers, agents, employees, volunteers, invitees, or contractors of the NATIVE TRIBE or of the NATIVE TRIBE' licensees; and (3) any accident, injury, or damage whatsoever occurring in or at the COUNTY'S parks and property. The NATIVE TRIBE hereby expressly indemnifies the COUNTY for the consequences of any negligent act or omission of the COUNTY, it's agents, servants, and employees, except that the NATIVE TRIBE will not be liable under this provision for damages arising out of the injury or damage to persons or property directly caused or resulting from the sole negligence of the COUNTY or any of its agents, servants, or employees.

The NATIVE TRIBE' obligation to defend and indemnify shall not be excused because of the NATIVE TRIBE' inability to evaluate liability or because the NATIVE TRIBE evaluates liability and determines the NATIVE TRIBE is not liable or determines the COUNTY is solely negligent. Only a

final adjudication or judgment finding the COUNTY solely negligent shall excuse performance of this provision by the NATIVE TRIBE. If a judgment finding the COUNTY solely negligent is appealed and the finding of sole negligence is reversed, the NATIVE TRIBE will be obligated to indemnify the COUNTY for the cost of the appeal(s). The NATIVE TRIBE shall pay all costs and fees related to this obligation and its enforcement by the COUNTY.

This provision shall also pertain to any claims brought against the COUNTY by any employee of the NATIVE TRIBE, contractor, subcontractor, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them.

The NATIVE TRIBE' obligations under this provision shall not be limited in any way by the NATIVE TRIBE' limit of or lack of sufficient insurance protection.

6. DENIAL AND LIMITATION OF SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES: The COUNTY specifically reserves the right to deny, terminate, limit, or curtail any scheduled development, activity or event approved by the COUNTY for any lawful reason.

7. NONASSIGNMENT: Neither the COUNTY nor the NATIVE TRIBE shall assign, transfer, or set over this agreement with any right, title, or interest herein to any person, firm, corporation, or other entity

8. DURATION: The duration of this agreement shall be twenty (20) years from the date of its execution by the COUNTY, and shall be automatically renewed thereafter for twenty (20) year terms unless terminated as provided in Paragraph 9 below.

9. TERMINATION: This agreement may be terminated without cause by either party upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other party.

10. MODIFICATION: This agreement may only be modified or altered with the written express approval of both parties.

11. INTEGRATION: This agreement shall supersede any and all other prior agreements heretofore entered into between the parties and shall be the sole source for rights, obligations, and recourse between the said parties.

12. VENUE AND ATTORNEYS' FEES: Venue for any and all litigation arising from this agreement shall be in the Circuit Court for Hernando County, Florida. The prevailing party in any litigation arising from this agreement shall receive reimbursement of its reasonable attorneys' fees from the non-prevailing party.

13. CONFLICT: To the extent any provision of this agreement conflicts in any way with the SWFWMD Agreement, the terms of the SWFWMD Agreement shall prevail.

14. SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY: None of the terms and conditions set forth herein shall be interpreted as a waiver of sovereign immunity and the COUNTY reserves all rights and privileges of sovereign immunity established by statute and caselaw.
