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**HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:**

On February 27, 1997 the Board of Sumter County Commissioners entered into a Sublease Agreement with the State of Florida, Division of Forestry for use of the building around the Wildwood forestry tower. The building had been subleased to the local Boy Scout troop as a meeting hall, but currently is vacant with no intent by Sumter County to occupy the property in the near future. Terms of the usage agreement requires the County give 6 months notice prior to termination. The lease is set to expire on February 27, 2011.

Staff recommends termination of the Use Permit with State of Florida, Division of Forestry and that the Board authorize Mr. Bradley Arnold to execute a letter notifying the Division of Forestry of the County's intent.

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
