Sandee,

I am not sure what information you are looking for. However, Section 197.323 which was attached to the Executive Summary provides the provision for the extension of roll during adjustment board hearings. We have 25 petitions and will begin to schedule hearings shortly. Those hearing will extend beyond November 1st. It is my understanding that the statutes state that if requested by the tax collector and approved by the BOCC the roll can be extended prior to the completion of the value adjustment board hearings, if completion would otherwise be the only cause for delay in the issuances of tax notices beyond November 1. This would have no affect on the issuances of tax notices.

We sent the same Executive Summary and same copy of the statutes to the Board during the month of October last year. The Board approved the extension of the tax roll. Please let me know if you need additional information.
