Dear Mr. Angeliadis:

As you are aware, our firm represents American Medical Response ("AMR") in the subject matter. We are in receipt of your letter to Chris Carmody dated March 1, 2011, and thank you for providing additional clarification of Sumter County's position in response to AMR's letter of protest. I am writing you this letter to provide you with the confirmation you requested in your March 1st letter and to advise that AMR will not withdraw its bid protest at this time.

We again request an opportunity to attempt to resolve this protest and have a "final finding" by Sumter County in accordance with the Section 906 of the Sumter County Code (Purchasing Policies and Procedures) (the "Purchasing Manual") prior to AMR determining whether or not to withdraw its protest as suggested in your February 2nd and March 1st letters.

It remains our position that the proposal submitted to Sumter County by Rural/Metro Corporation of Florida ("Rural/Metro") expressly violated the terms of the subject Request for Proposal ("RFP") certification, both the requirements and the intent of the Sumter County Code, the Florida Statutes and relevant Florida case law. By misrepresenting that sections of its proposal were its own, when, as shown, they were copied from AMR's proposal submitted to the City of Orlando in April 2010, Rural/Metro's response to the RFP was not responsive or not responsible given this express violation of the certification. A point we are confident will be brought to light should the County proceed with submitting this protest to the Department of Administrative Hearings for an Administrative Review at this time.
