Ride Right LLC out of Lake St. Louis, MO: all copies were enclosed, insurance certificate documentation was included, pricing is as follows: Ambulatory rate per trip \$17.08; Wheelchair rate per trip \$19.33; Stretcher trips per trip \$78.00; Bariatric trips per trip \$92.00; Special group and special event rate per hour \$34.66; Deviated fixed route per hour \$34.66.

The Selection Committee met on 5-5-2011 at 10:00am in Room 102 located within The Villages Sumter County Service Center and decided to hold vendor presentations with all three submitting companies.

After the meeting on 5-5-2011, Tracy LeFevre with Leopard Transport, contacted staff via email requesting to remove Leopard Transport from the remainder of the RFP process.

Vendor Presentations were held on 5-6-2011 at 9:00am in Room 102 located within The Villages Sumter County Service Center. Presentations were given by Ride Right, LLC and Dash Transport. After presentations the Selection Committee reconvened to score the two presenting companies. Scores from the Selection Committee are as follows: Dash Transport received a total score of 9.32 points and Ride Right, LLC received a total score of 14.2 points.

The Selection Committee is recommending to the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners to award and enter into contract negotiations with Ride Right, LLC for RFP 006-0-2011/AT.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Sumter County Transit (SCT) has operated as a BOCC department since 1993. The General Fund contributions for services are match-related and will trend downward only with decreased grant funding and will trend upward with increased grant funding. Grant funding for FY12 will increase; thus the General Fund request has increased with or without privatization of transportation services. Approximately two thirds of the Transit budget is comprised of grant dollars.

Thus far in FY11, SCT increased trips by over 8.8 percent with two less driver positions. It is expected that additional trips will be added in FY12 whether or not the department is privatized due to improved management efficiencies.

If Ride Right, LLC successfully negotiates a contract for assuming Sumter County transportation services, two positions will be maintained in the Community Services Division for contract management and quality assurance. Ride Right, LLC has a positive history of providing non-emergency medical transportation, paratransit, and deviated shuttle operations of similar size and scope within FL and other states. This should be an advantage for Sumter County when Medicaid transportation moves under the umbrella of managed care organizations in the near term. Therefore, staff recommends Board approval to enter into contract negotiations with Ride Right, LLC to assume the operations of SCT as outlined in the request for proposals.

Bid opening meeting was held on April 28, 2011 at 10:05am in Room 208 located within The Villages Sumter County Service Center, 7375 Powell Road, Wildwood, FL 34785.

Bradley Arnold and Amanda Taylor were present to represent county staff.

Amanda stated after the bid opening that proposal copies would be distributed to the Selection Committee. She also stated that all communication must continue through Amanda Taylor until an award is made by the Board of Sumter County Commissioners. The Selection Committee consists of Deb Barsell, David Levesque, and Michael Woods. Amanda stated the Selection Committee will meet on May 5<sup>th</sup> at 10am in Room 102 of The Villages Sumter County Service Center. Amanda stated as listed within the RFP that all vendors who submitted a proposal must attend the Selection Meeting on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Vendor presentations will be held May 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am in Room 102 of The Villages Sumter County Service Center. The Selection Committee's recommendation will be taken to the Board of Sumter County Commissioners on May 24<sup>th</sup>.

Amanda stated no addendums were issued. Each proposal package must have one original copy, one electronic copy, and five additional copies enclosed. Amanda stated insurance certificates were given to the Risk Management Department to evaluate for proper coverage.

The proposals were opened as follows in no particular order:

1. Leopard Transport out of Ocala, FL: all copies were enclosed, insurance certificate documentation was included, no pricing was provided for Option #1, pricing for Option #2 was listed as follows: Per Trip Reimbursement of Ambulatory Trips with Carrier(s) Dispatching and Scheduling \$20.98; Per Trip Reimbursement of Wheelchair Trips with Carrier(s) Dispatching and Scheduling \$40.75; Per Trip Reimbursement of Stretcher Trips with Carrier(s) Dispatching and Scheduling \$80.00; Per Trip Reimbursement of Bariatric Trips with Carrier(s) Dispatching and Scheduling \$160.00; Special Group and Event rate \$45.50 hourly.
2. Dash Transport out of Inverness, FL: all copies were enclosed, insurance certificate documentation was included; pricing for Option #1 is as follows: Transportation Disadvantaged Trips ambulatory rate of \$11.50 per trip and a wheelchair rate of \$24.00 per trip; Paratransit Special Group and Special Event trips at a rate of \$48.00 per hour; Deviated-fixed Route Service at a flat hourly rate of \$48.00 per driver hour. Pricing for Option #2 is as follows: Transportation Disadvantaged Trips ambulatory rate of \$11.50 per trip and a wheelchair rate of \$24.00 per trip; Transportation Disadvantaged Stretcher trips paid a per trip rate of \$200.00 for the full period of each trip; Transportation Disadvantaged Bariatric trips paid a per trip rate of \$200.00 for the full period of each trip; Paratransit Special Group and Special Event trips at a rate of \$48.00 per hour; Deviated-fixed Route Service at a flat hourly rate of \$48.00 per driver hour.

The Selection Committee met on 5-5-2011 at 10:00am in Room 102 at The Villages Sumter County Service Center, 7375 Powell Road, Wildwood, FL 34785.

Deb Barsell, David Levesque, and Michael Woods were present representing the Selection Committee. Amanda Taylor was present representing county staff.

Amanda passed the sign in sheet around. She stated since the meeting was mandatory for all vendors who submitted a proposal, everyone needed to make sure they signed in. Amanda stated Vendor Presentations would begin tomorrow at 9:00am in Room 102. After presentations the Selection Committee would reconvene to score the vendors and make a recommendation to the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners on 5-24-2011. Amanda stated the Selection Committee did have the option to bypass presentations and score at the meeting today.

Amanda reminded all attendees that discussion held today would be only between the Selection Committee.

Amanda asked the Selection Committee to disclose if they had been contacted by any of the vendors regarding questions related to the RFP. Michael and Deb had not been contacted by any of the three firms. David was contacted by one firm via phone, asking how many proposals and what companies submitted. There was no other discussion within that conversation regarding the RFP.

Amanda then turned the meeting over to the Selection Committee for discussion.

Deb asked the committee to discuss the proposals in the following order: Leopard, Dash, and Ride Right. The committee agreed.

Deb stated in her opinion Leopard's proposal was non-responsive because it did not contain required information as specified within the RFP. David and Michael stated it lacked information but did not agree it was non-responsive. David stated he was concerned about the fuel addenda listed within their RFP.

The committee stated they had several questions for the three vendors and agreed that vendor presentations would be helpful in addressing questions unanswered within the RFP responses.

Questions and/or areas of concern for all three vendors (Leopard, Dash, & Ride Right) are as follows:

1. Integration of new software or use of WindTrip in the future; 2. What proposed scheduling software would be used; 3. Demonstrate how each company would comply with the requirements for EVerify; 4. Provide a better demonstration of similar projects, how each company would take on this project, how staffing transition would be handled, and demonstrating thorough knowledge of the coordinated system and its partners.

Specific questions for Dash are as follows: 1. If awarded how the leasing company contract would be managed; 2. How they came to their pricing proposal, individual rates; 3. Provide an organizational chart, how many drivers they will have, how many schedulers they will have, and their vision for structure of the project at hand.

Specific questions for Ride Right are as follows: 1. Demonstrate how flexible they are on proposed office staff; 2. Describe their relationship with MTM in detail; 3. How will the company, which is fairly new, staff people in Sumter County; 4. How was the pricing for bariatric and stretcher service established; 5. What agreements or contingency agreements are in place for bariatric and stretcher services.

The committee agreed on 30 minute blocks (15 minute presentation/15 minute Q&A) for each company. The committee agreed to take the companies in alphabetical order for presentations. The schedule starting at 9am would be Dash, Leopard, and then Ride Right. Amanda stated a five (5) minute break would be taken between each presentation for the next company to set-up. She also stated if handouts were being provided four (4) copies would be needed. Amanda stated Sumter County had a projector screen and projector that could be utilized but all other electronic equipment would need to be provided by the presenting company.

The meeting adjourned at 10:24am.
