HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Sumter County's Adopt-A-Highway program began in 1996. Under the agreement, each group/individual must commit to perform a minimum of eight (8) litter pickups for a two year period on an adopted two mile span of right-of-way.

South Sumter High School NJROTC signed their original contract in 2003. The group has continuously made their required number of litter pick-ups each year. Their agreement is for litter removal totaling 2. miles:

Beginning at intersection W. Palm Avenue/C-475N to intersection of W. Walker Avenue/
C-475N

Beginning at intersection CR 542E/C-475 south for 1 mile

Charlie Jacobs, representative for the organization, has agreed to abide to all safety and contractual procedures.

If Board of County Commissioners agrees to execute litter removal extension agreement, two (s) of the three (3) originals should be returned after executed. The third original will be retained with Board Minutes.
