1. Based on your #1 below, I will have before the BOCC under my reports the final approval of the temporary road closure as we discussed (one-lane of traffic on 462) for the parade. Further, since no use is planned for the park community center – I will direct Public Works not to rent the facility for the weekend to ensure no misuse occurs. Finally, use of the ball fields by citizens I hope will occur; however, formal tournament play is prohibited on Sunday since that is considered an event that requires the tournament planner to provide insurance for coverage.
2. The education of the community will occur via the BOCC knowledge of this email and the final comments related to the fact that no event was approved for Sunday. We will attempt to communicate with the Mr. Green below to formally announce that the even on Sunday is cancelled. LT Nordle and I have discussed the fact that education on Sunday as people that did not get the message will need to occur. If LT Nordle gains approval from Chief Deputy Terry, I am sure that more direct education can be provided through the Sheriff's Office as deputies communicate with the residents of Royal in advance of the event.

Thank you. On last night, the Royal Library Association met to finalize Royal Homecoming events they are sponsoring. Below are our final decisions:
