HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Section 13-363(b)(7) of the Sumter County Land Development Code requires Board approval for any temporary special entertainment event that shall exceed a maximum of 14 days (consecutive or not) within a 1 year period.

Brown's Farm located on US 301 at the Sumter/Marion County Line has requested approval to allow a festival including a corn maize, monster truck rides, bounce house, hayrides, pony rides, food vendors, and additional kids activities from October 7, 2011 to November 20, 2011. The hours of operation are as proposed as follows:

- Sunday – 9 a.m.-10 p.m.
 - Monday – Thursday – 3 p.m.–10 p.m.
 - Friday & Saturday – 9 a.m.-11 p.m.
- *Hours may vary during weekdays to allow for school field trips.

The applicants have received approval from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Sumter County Environmental Health. They are currently working with Sumter County Fire Services for the event. In addition, they are also working with the Sumter County Building Department for any building permits required.

A written narrative, site plan, and poster for the event are included for review.


