Volkert is please to submit this proposal to provide professional engineering services for the above referenced project.

The proposed scope of services, schedule and fee estimate are described below:

SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. Prepare construction plans for the resurfacing of C 470 from the Lake Panasoffkee Outfall Canal to SR 44. The anticipated major element of the design are:
 - Site Investigation (data collection) to identify topography of road side slopes and lateral obstructions.
 - Design to new guardrail in accordance with current FDOT design criteria
 - Addition of two foot paved shoulders
 - New roadway pavement markings
 - New roadway regulatory signage
2. Prepare and submit 100 % Design Plans (signed & sealed) to FDOT for review and approval.
3. Prepare and submit a comprehensive bid package (include all required specifications) in accordance with FDOT/FHWA rules and regulations for ARRA Stimulus Project.
4. Prepared and submit and sign & sealed Engineer's Option of Probable Construction Costs to FDOT for review and approval.
5. Provide the required permitting services.
6. Provide bid assistance in accordance with Sumter County, FDOT and FWHA rules and regulations for ARRA Stimulus Projects.

SCHEDULE:

Volkert can complete tasks 1 – 4 within 60 days of received purchase order.

FEE:

The tasks outlined in the scope of services above can be accomplished for a lump sum fee of lump sum of \$41,250.

EXCLUSIONS

The fee does not include survey services, geotechnical services and construction services.
