HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Federal Section 5311 Capital & Operational Assistance Grant provides funding for rural and small urban areas for the purpose of supporting public transportation. Funding is apportioned on a formula basis to each of the state’s Community Transportation Coordinators serving non-urbanized populations. The maximum federal share for operating assistance is 50 percent of the net operating costs.

The Authorizing Resolution authorizes the County Administrator to sign the grant application and all documents relating to the grant process. The actual grant award will be presented to the BOCC upon approval from FDOT under the County Administrator Report as information only.
