Sumter County Commissioners are currently elected "at large", meaning each County Commission district race is voted on by electors residing in all five County Commission Districts. The proposition below would change the existing procedure for election of Sumter County Commissioners by instituting "single member representation", meaning that each County Commission District race would be decided by electors residing in each of those districts only.
