HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

This FDOT LFA will assist FDOT in the cost of installing painted mast arms at the intersection of US 301 and SR 44 as part of FDOT’s resurfacing project instead of galvanized span wire poles. FDOT’s project number 442875-1-52-01, resurfacing of SR 44 from US 301 to the Lake County line. FDOT shall perform preliminary engineering, prepare all design plans, acquire all right-of-way, perform the construction, provide all necessary engineering supervision, and otherwise perform all other necessary work. The project will begin construction after October 2021.

Sumter County’s responsibility is to budget and fund the upgrade to mast arms as per the LFA, with payment to FDOT on or before August 1, 2021.
