

RESOLUTION 2021-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN SUMTER COUNTY FOR VARIOUS SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN SUMTER COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF PRIOR FEE RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF FEES COLLECTED – WAIVING OF SOME FEES IN CASE OF HARDSHIP; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 154, Florida Statutes, subsection 154.06 (1) provides that each county may establish, and each county public health department may collect fees for services, provided that a schedule of such fees is established by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, or by rule of the Florida Department of Health respectively; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, desires to provide for collection of fees for services rendered by the Florida Department of Health in Sumter County, which are not otherwise provided for by rule of the Florida Department of Health;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida that:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. **Repeal of Prior Fee Resolution.** Resolution, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida on July 24, 2018, relating to fees to be charged by the Florida Department of Health in Sumter County is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. **Fee Schedule.** The Florida Department of Health in Sumter County shall charge the following fees until such time a revision is needed:

Section 4. **Disposition of Collected Fees.** The Florida Department of Health in Sumter County shall assure that all fees collected under this Ordinance shall be deposited in the Florida Department of Health in Sumter County Trust Fund maintained by the State Treasurer in accordance with Section 154.06 (2), Florida Statutes.

Section 5. **Waiver of Fees.** The Director of the Florida Department of Health in Sumter County or a designee, may waive any fee for hardship or other legitimate reason on a case by case basis.

Section 6. **Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of This Resolution.

Section 7. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective on the date passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County.
