

CARES ACT FUNDING
AGREEMENT Y2284
Amendment No. 2

This Second Amendment made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management with headquarters in Tallahassee, Florida (hereinafter referred to as the "Division," or "FDEM,"), and **Sumter County**, (hereinafter referred to as the "County").

WHEREAS, the Division and County have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Division has provided a funding agreement under the Coronavirus Relief Fund created by the CARES Act, section 601(d) of the Social Security Act; and

WHEREAS, the Division and the County desire to modify the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement expired on December 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Appropriations Act enacted on December 27, 2020, extended the period during which states, tribes, and local governments can incur costs for which they intend to use the Coronavirus Relief Fund from December 30, 2020 to December 30, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Division and County desire to reinstate and extend the terms of the Agreement.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the Parties contained set forth:

1. The Agreement is hereby reinstated and extended as though it had never expired.
2. Paragraph 6 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

(6) PERIOD OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be effective on **March 1, 2020** and shall end on **June 30, 2021**, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (15) TERMINATION. In accordance with section 215.971(1)(d), Florida Statutes, the Subrecipient may expend funds authorized by this Agreement "only for allowable costs resulting from obligations incurred during the specific agreement period."

3. This Second Amendment is hereby incorporated into the Agreement. All terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect except as otherwise expressly set forth herein. The effective date of this Second Amendment is December 31, 2020.
