**HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:**

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Sumter County Board of County Commissioner (BOCC) was sent \$5,776,567 with Phase 1 disbursement of Cares Act funds to be spent by December 30, 2020. Sumter County BOCC was assigned additional funding that could be requested for reimbursement in Phase 2 and 3 for a total of \$10,397,821. As of January 2021, Sumter County BOCC has spent \$2,432,277.44 of the Phase 1 funding. This agreement is a request to extend the use of the funding to June 30, 2021. (see Cares Act Spending Plan)
