Dear Ms. Stults,

The City of Wildwood and Sumter County reviewed the Preliminary Alternative Corridors as depicted in Exhibit A.

Both jurisdictions voted to support the transmission of this letter that supports a modified "Alternative Corridor Central" as well as formally reject the other alternative corridors.

The modification required in support of the Alternative Corridor Central is the starting point of the extension that shall not proceed North of SR 44 while East of I-75. The basis of this requirement is to reduce the adverse impact on the historic African-American community of Royal, to eliminate the impact of the existing business operations East of I-75, and to provide for a faster alignment for the Westerly parallel corridor to I-75 to achieve the balance of the Alternative Corridor Central.
