

Amendment #3
Agreement Between Sumter County, Florida and the University of Florida Board of Trustees for Medical Director and Associate Medical Director Services

This Amendment #3 is made and entered into this 22nd day of March, 2022, between the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County Florida ("County"), 7375 Powell Road, Wildwood, Florida 34785 and the University of Florida Board of Trustees, for the benefit of the Department of Emergency Medicine, College of Medicine, University of Florida, a public body corporate organization under Florida Law ("University"), Post Office Box 100205, Gainesville, Florida 32610-0205.

WHEREAS, the parties executed an original agreement ("Agreement") dated February 11, 2020 for Medical Director and Associate Medical Director Services, which was amended on October 13, 2020 to expand the scope of work for the Medical Director and Associate Medical Director and to add the Villages Public Safety Department, and on October 27, 2020 to clarify expanded scope of work and the rate to reflect the services.

WHEREAS, County wishes to further expand the Scope of Work for the Medical Director, adjust Appendix A, and adjust rate.

WHEREAS, County wishes to obtain Medical Director and Associate Medical Director services and for University to provide Medical Director and Associate Medical Director services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Effective March 22, 2022, the February 1, 2020 Agreement between the parties, is hereby amended to include the duties listed in Attachment A, which is incorporated in full, and to include:

Upon the successful launch of FirstPass, provide monthly reporting of quality metrics defined by the medical directors to include at a minimum, ACS/STEMI, Stroke, Trauma, Airway Management, Cardiac Arrest, and Non-Transport/Refusals.

2. Effective March 22, 2022, paragraph 4.2 will be replaced in its entirety with the following:

4.2 University Physicians. The parties agree that University shall provide services and perform its duties as required by this Agreement, through its University-employed faculty physician(s), including the assigned Medical Director and Associate Medical Director, and any other assigned University-employed physician (including Fellows), as employees/agents of University (collectively, "Medical Director and Associate Medical Director"). The parties agree that **Alison Leung, MD** will be the Medical Director assigned by University, and that **Alison Leung, MD** will also serve as the Interim Associate Medical Director assigned by University pursuant to this Agreement until an appropriate replacement can be named. As mutually agreed upon by the parties, the University may assign additional physician(s) to assist the Medical Director and Associate Medical Director in the provision of services specified herein.

3. Effective October 1, 2022, Appendix A will be revised to remove the Villages Public Safety Department.
4. Effective October 1, 2022, Paragraph 3.1 of the Agreement is deleted in full and replaced with the following paragraph:

3.1 University shall be paid at a rate of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$140,000) annually ("Annual Amount") to provide Medical Director, Associate Medical Director services as outlined in Appendix A. University shall invoice County the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) on or about the last working day of each quarterly period for services provided in the just-concluded quarter. Payments shall be made by County pursuant to the Florida Local Government Prompt Payment Act after receipt of proper invoice

submitted by University. An additional three percent (3%) increase will be applied starting the second year of the Agreement and applied annually.

7. Except as expressly modified by this Amendment #3, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement, as amended, remain in full force and effect for the term of the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have made and executed this Agreement on the respective dates under each signature: Sumter County, Florida, through its Board of County Commissioners, signing by and through its Chairman, and by The University of Florida Board of Trustees for The Benefit of the Department of Emergency Medicine, College of Medicine, University of Florida, by its duly authorized representative.
