This ordinance amends the Sumter County Code to provide for assessment of staff costs and serious or repeat violations associated with code enforcement cases.

The amendment provides that a person found in violation of the Sumter County Code by the Special Master, shall immediately be assessed with the obligation to pay for all costs incurred through the date of the hearing. The resolution establishes the specific fines and fee schedule for staff costs.

Section 2-96 would be added to Chapter 2, Article V, Special Master Code Enforcement to address the code enforcement process for serious or repeat violators.
