A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR SUMTER COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, on September 13, 2022, adopted Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Tentative Millage Rates following a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation with Sumter County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Board of County Commissioners as \$17,884,681,580.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, that:

- 1) The Fiscal Year 2022-2023 tentative millage rate is 5.5900 mills, which is lower than the rolled-back rate of 5.5936 mills.
- 2) The voted debt service millage is 0.
- 3) This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
