Dear Mr. Arnold:

As you may be aware, on September 24, 2022, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order No. 22-218, as amended by Executive Order No. 22-219, declaring a state of emergency for the State of Florida due to Hurricane Ian.

Pursuant to Section 252.363, Florida Statutes, the declaration of a state of emergency tolled the period remaining to exercise rights under a permit, development order or other authorization for the duration of the state of emergency (60 days) and provide for an extension of six months following the tolled period. The tolling and extension provisions apply to the expiration of: (1) development orders issued by a local government; (2) building permits; and (3) Department of Environmental Protection or water management district permits issued pursuant to part IV of Chapter 373, Florida Statutes.

Therefore, this constitutes notice that Miami 1st & 8th, LLC intends to rely on the extension provided by Section 252.363, Florida Statutes, as noted above, for the following extension approvals:

Operating Permit No. S2021-0012 which currently expires February 25, 2027


