Good morning Ms. Waylans,

It was a pleasure speaking with you this morning. I understand your concerns and I appreciate the fact that you have gained 300 +/- signatures of the 474 homes in the Chitty Chatty neighborhood.

Attached is the intersection evaluation for the full access median opening at Morse Boulevard and the Chitty Chatty/Sandalwood intersection. As we discussed, we took a look at the crash database between when the study was completed last year and now (March 22, 2022 and February 28, 2023), and there was one crash reported at the intersection. This crash occurred when a vehicle exiting the Chitty Chatty development, to head north on Morse Boulevard, right turned and side swiped a vehicle that was already heading north on Morse Boulevard. Additionally, we looked at the 24-hour traffic counts completed last year and the 24-hour traffic counts this year, and the difference is less than a two percent increase, which not statistically significant and will not change the outcome of the attached study.

Normally, we do not initiate changes to the intersection, like a directional median opening unless we have a documented safety concern. We do not have that now with only a single crash is six years.
