Brad,

Today, we filed:

1. Complaint for Injunction
2. Emergency Motion for Temporary Injunction
3. Notice of Lis Pendens
4. Summons to Rattray Farm, LLC
5. Summons to Tyla Rattray as Registered Agent, Rattray Farm, LLC

Attached are copies of the Complaint and Emergency Motion for Temporary Injunction. Once the Summons and Lis Pendens are issued by the Clerk, we'll have the Summons, Complaint, and Motion served on Rattray Farm, LLC, and the Lis Pendens will be recorded. Mr. Rattray will have 20 days to respond to the complaint once served. I've asked that the motion be granted as an ex parte motion, but I don't know that the Judge will grant that. However, we have asked for an emergency hearing prior to service in the hopes of getting a temporary injunction before the 20 days, although I'm not sure the Judge will grant it without first serving the defendant given the type of activity at issue.

Unless you have objections, I plan to provide notice to the neighbors who have submitted code complaints as to any evidentiary hearing on the emergency motion to see if they have any interest in testifying in support of the motion.
