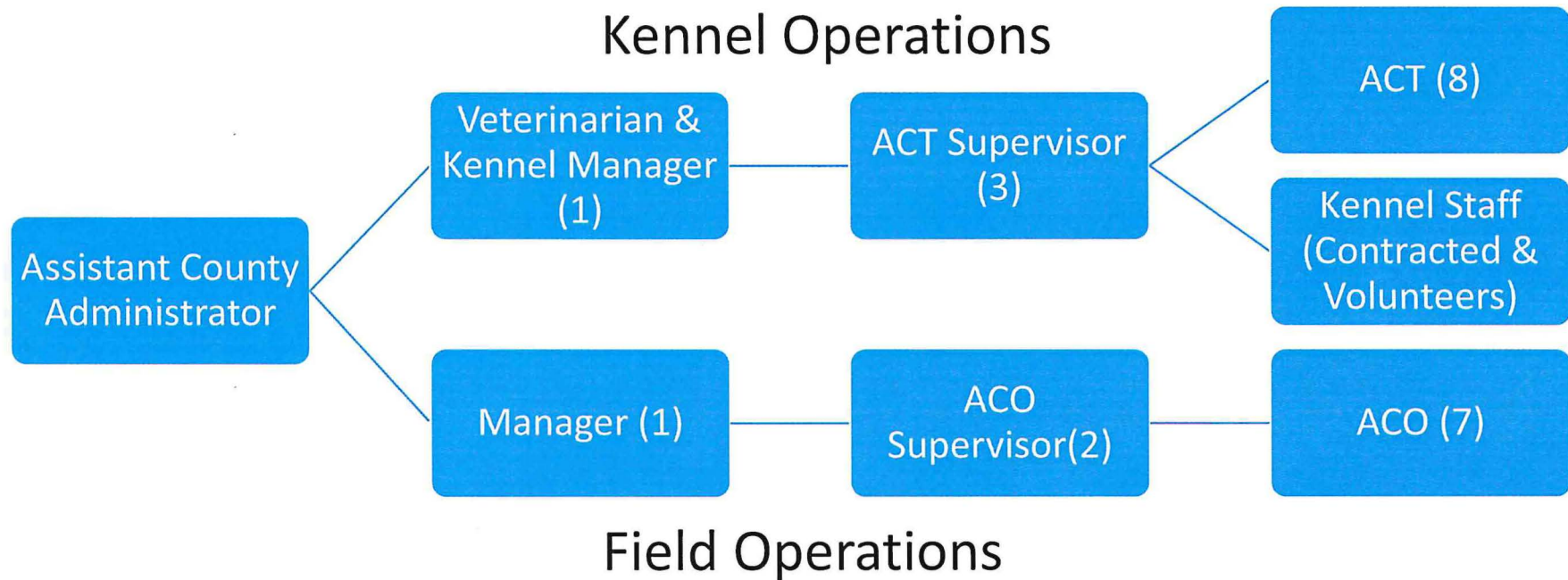
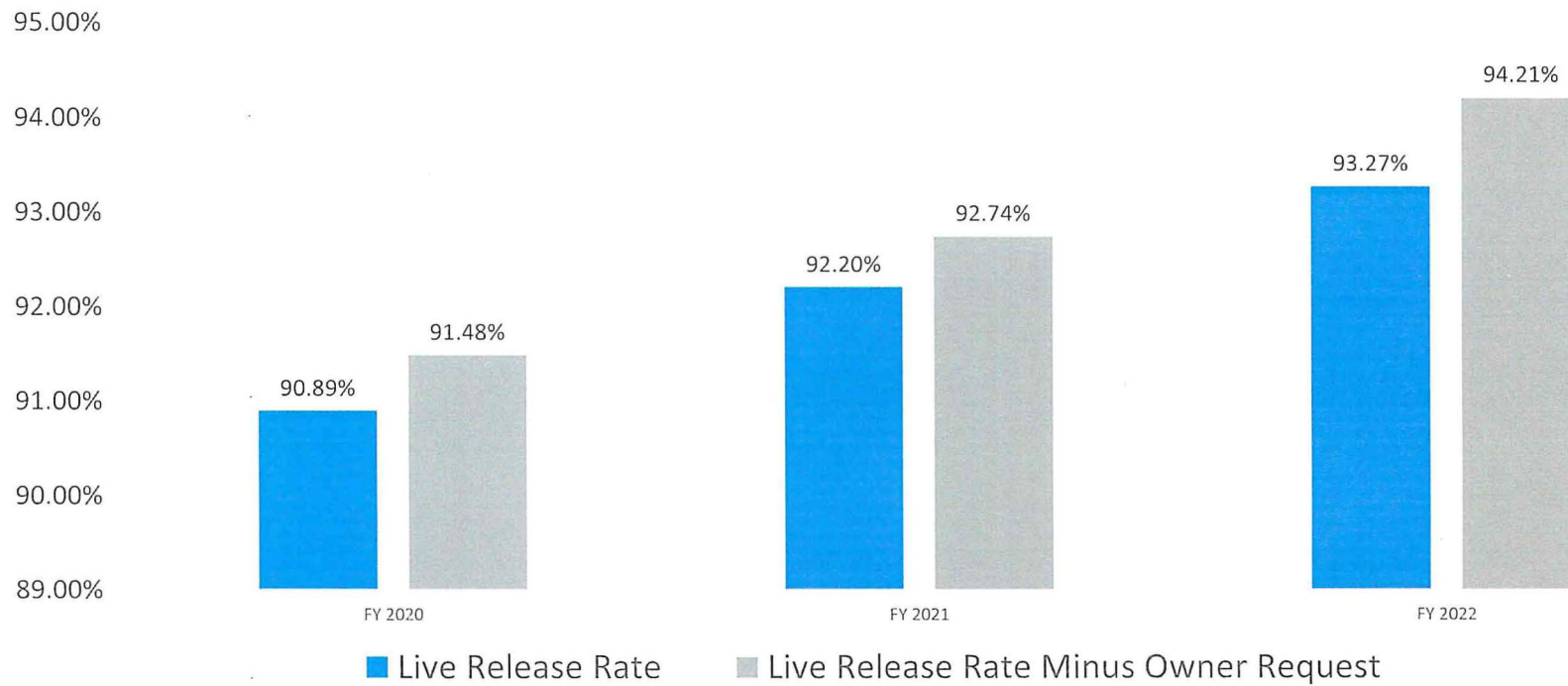


Animal Services Organizational Structure

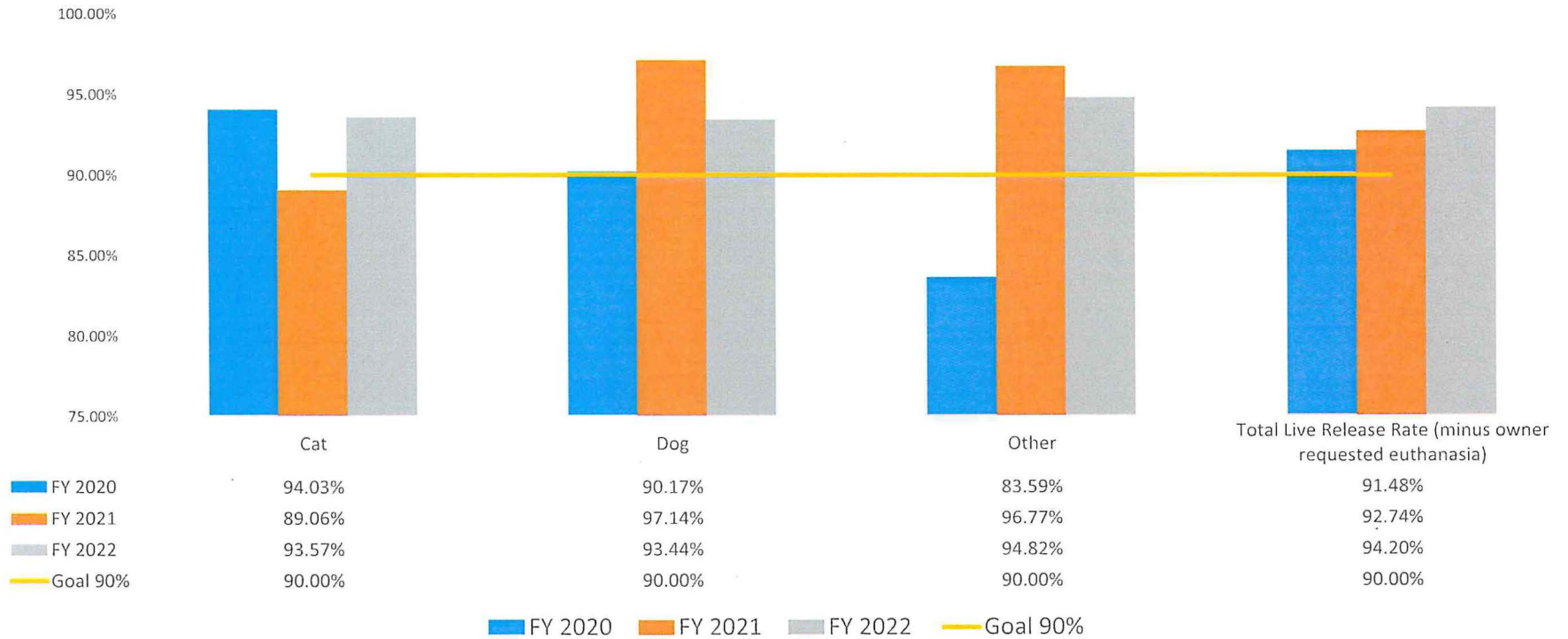


FY 2020 - 2022 Total Live Release rates

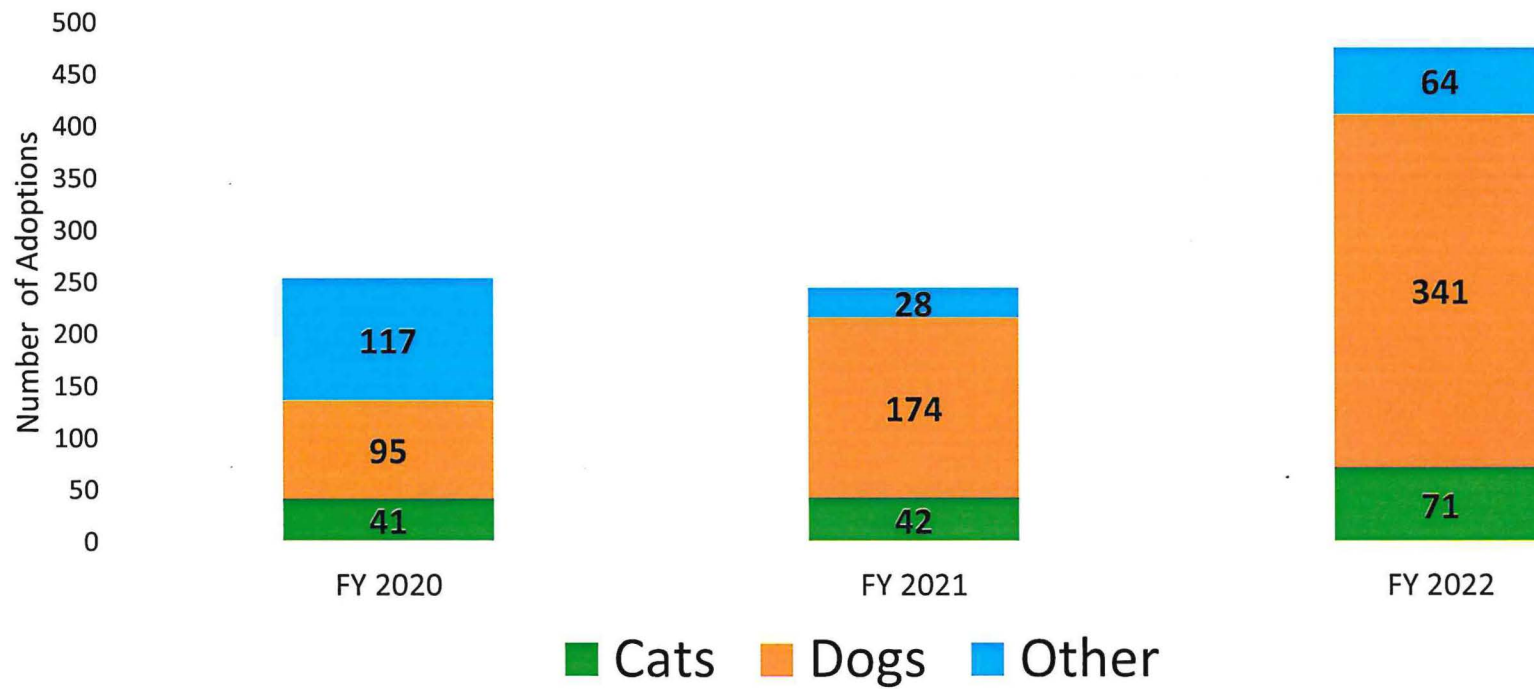


FY 2020 - 2022 Live Release Rate Analysis

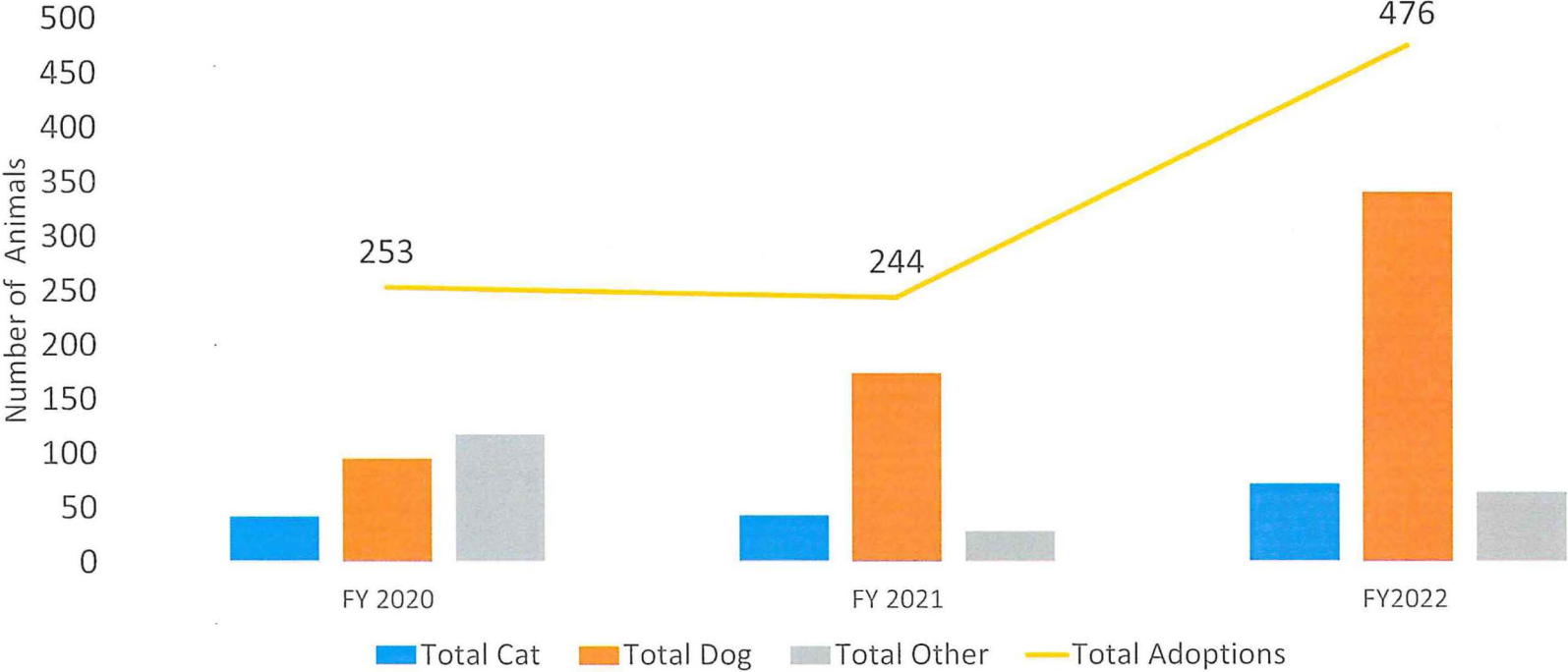
Live Release Percentage Rates

Accomplishments

- Transition to ShelterLuv reporting system for kennel operations
- On campus medical procedure
- Remodel of cat intake area and revision of intake process
- Responded to 3,050 service requests in FY 22
- Reviewed *The Association of Shelter Veterinarians 2022 revised Guidelines for Standards of Care in Animal Shelters* and its impact on Sumter County
- Implemented Pathway Planning program for each animal at risk for fear, anxiety, or stress
