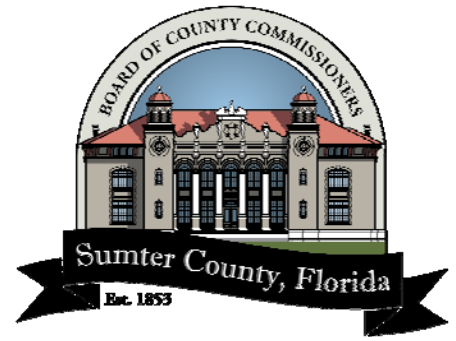

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter regarding the operating permit OP-22-08354 issued November 8, 2022 for the continued operation of an existing internet café on parcel D01J100A. Multiple site inspections starting in January of 2023 to present by our inspectors noted the business continually closed and not in operation upon each visit.

Pursuant to Sumter County Code Section 13-343 (c)(7), permits may be revoked when the applicant fails to comply with any or all of the conditions set forth within the approved operating permit.

The Sumter County Board of County Commissioners voted in favor of this notice and the date certain of revoking OP-22-08354 effective June 6, 2023.

The nature of the violations and the conditions in which they violate are as follows:

Section A – General Terms and Conditions

Condition #5. If business activities cease for a period of six months, this Permit shall expire unless extended by the Board upon request of the Operator. A request for an extension must be submitted to the Board, in writing, at least sixty (60) days prior to the Permit's expiration date.

Violation: Attempts have been made for the past four consecutive months to perform an inspection with the location being closed and not in operation each time.
