A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE FEE SCHEDULE PURSUANT TO SUMTER COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 8 FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES DIVISION, SECTION 8-3(d)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida (Board) is the governing body in and for Sumter County, and;

WHEREAS, the Board adopted an interlocal service boundary agreement with each of Sumter County's five municipalities to coordinate or consolidate services; and

WHEREAS, the sub agreements for building permitting and inspection services as well as fire services delegates the fire plan review and inspections to the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board provides annual fire inspections of businesses through its designated fire service providers; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes §633.208 requires each county to enforce the Florida Fire Prevention Code as promulgated in Chapter 69A-60, Florida Administrative code; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes §125.56(2) allows the Board to provide a schedule of fees to help defer the costs of annual inspections and enforcement of the Florida Building Code and the Florida Fire Prevention Code; and

WHEREAS, subsection (d) of Section 8-3, of the Sumter County Code of Ordinances, provides for the establishment of user fees and related charges for services performed or rendered by the designated fire service providers operating within the jurisdiction of Sumter County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution establishes the fee schedule for properties required to receive Annual Fire Inspection and a fee schedule for Hazardous Materials Response; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a schedule of fees for functions preformed under the Florida Fire Prevention Code are necessary in order the recoup the expenses associated with providing those services and performing these functions;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners hereby determines that: the adoption of this fee schedule is in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare.

Section 1. Fee Schedule – Properties Required to Receive an Annual Fire Inspection.

The Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, adopts the Fee Schedule for properties required to receive Annual Fire Inspection, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

Section 2. Fee Schedule – Hazardous Materials Response.

The Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, adopts the Fee Schedule for Hazardous Materials Response at the current (at the time of incident) Federal Emergency Management Agency “Schedule of Equipment Rates” for equipment use; and “current market value (actual cost of replacement)” for consumable supplies.

Section 3. Effective Date. The Resolution shall take effect October 1, 2023, and shall remain in effect unless otherwise modified by subsequent ordinance or resolution of the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners.
